## **Definitions and Background**

Human Trafficking and Modern Slavery, though separate issues, are terms which are very often linked together because of their close relationship. However, although it is common to be trafficked across international boundaries and enslaved, it is also possible to be a slave within one's own country. We tend to use the term modern slavery to distinguish it from past forms, but slavery in one form or another has been present in many societies throughout history.

# Human Dignity

Human Dignity is the **main principle of CST**. Made in the image and likeness of God, every person is created with intrinsic dignity, with a worth and a sacredness that comes from their Creator. The Catholic Church teaches therefore that human life is to be valued and respected. The victims of

human trafficking and slavery are made to work long hours for little or no pay and for the profit of others. They are often abused and regarded as worthless, treated simply as an object for another's benefit. The person's God-given human dignity is either ignored, forgotten or despised.
